# Spring One Term Year 3/4



### English

We will be starting the term with writing first-person diary entries based on our 'visits' to different habitats. as we experience and embrace the climate, landscape, flora and fauna. Next, we will be focusing on stories from other cultures We will be able to compose and recount a story using descriptive features, allowing us to describe a setting using cultural references.

#### Art

Print making and textiles

In this block, pupils will respond to the traditional designs of kente cloth. They will create a range of surfaces, combining colour, texture and pattern. Pupils will explore the symbolic significance of colour.

#### Science

#### Animals including humans:

In science this term we are looking at the different types of teeth that we have as humans and what they do, the digestive system and food chains.

#### Maths

Year 3:

We will use multiplication facts for the 2, 5 and 10 multiplication tables, including recognising odd and even numbers. We will be able to multiply 2-digit numbers by 1-digit numbers, using mental strategies and progressing to formal written methods

#### Year 4:

We will recognise and use factor pairs and commutativity in mental calculations. Recall multiplication and division facts for multiplication tables up to  $12 \times 12$ . To be able to multiply a three digit number by a one digit number.
